Type	Anthelmintic effective against Nematodes and Tapeworms for oral use in cattle, sheep and goats.
Composition	Oxfendazole 1250 mg Excipient q.s.p 1 bolus
Intended for	Cattle, sheep, goat.
Uses	Treatment and prevention of pulmonary and intestinal strongylosis including Type Two Ostertiagiasis and tapeworm infections with Moniezia Oxfendazole is from the Benzimidazole Family noted for the high effectiveness (95-100%) against intestinal and pulmonary strongyles as well as Tapeworms of the Moniezia type. Safe to use with pregnant animals (except sheep and goats) Lowest dosage of all the Benzimidazoles
Dosage & Administration	To be given orally: Cattle: 4.5mg/kg bodyweight. 1 bolus per 280 kg bodyweight. Sheep/goats: 5mg/kg bodyweight. 1 bolus per 250 kg bodyweight.
Warnings	Do not use concurrently with Salicylanilides
Withdrawal Periods	Meat and offal: Cattle 28 days, Sheep and goats: 14 days Milk: Cattle 5 days Sheep and goats: do not use on lactating animals producing milk for human consumption
